There is hardly a day that goes by that I do not meet or have a conversation with someone who is searching to gain a better understanding of God's will is for his life.

1. There must be the practice of self-denial.

The Apostle Paul, speaking to the Church at Corinth says this in **2 Corinthians 3:2** – "You are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read by all men ..."

An epistle is a letter, and what Paul is saying here is that our lives are an epistle...our lives are a letter. Not only that, they are known and read by all men in the sense that their conversion was a well-known fact in the whole area. People realized that a change had come over these people and that they had turned to God from idols, and they were now living separated lives. They were the evidence of Paul's divine ministry. My friend, people need to see the beauty of Jesus in you.



We must remember what Jesus said in John 15:16 – "You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you."

When we choose to practice self-denial and build a life's message, we will find that we are in the center of God's will for our lives. Our problem is that many times we want to look ahead and know God's will so we can decide if we like it or not. That should not be our focus. Our focus should be to live lives of surrender, knowing God's eternal will for our lives in every area will simply "emerge" if we will only surrender moment-by-moment.

My friend, when you are seeking to know the will of God about something, ask yourself, "Do I have first things first?" Am I walking in the Spirit? Am I willing to say yes to God even if I do not understand it? From this position, I know from personal experience God will not only show you His will, but He will make it happen, His way.
