## THE SPOKEN WORD

We have been broadcasting "Abiding Above with Chris Hodges" for 9 full years this April. We are so thankful for you and how God leads you to give!

We signed a new contract with *WCRV Bott Radio 640 AM* just two days ago. This investment of *\$19,500* gets God's Word out through the largest Christian radio station in the nation. Bott Radio Network, reaches the Mid-South region from Memphis, TN and broadcasts into eight surrounding states.

This is how it works: Abiding Above's radio spot goes out 5 days a week at a peak driving time (when people are listening to the radio while driving home from work.) Our time slot is 5:01 pm, 5 days a week (M-F). We also have rotating spots that come on at various times in a 24-hour period. This radio advertisement sends people to our website where full versions of sermons are housed, and where we archive our blog posts.
