How should a Christian live in days of uncertainty? Many people are asking and wondering... is God in control?

<u>Psalm 47:7-8</u> – "For God is the King of all the earth; sing praises with understanding. <u>God</u> <u>reigns over the nations</u>; <u>God sits on His holy throne</u>."

Yes, my friend, God is now, and has forever, been in absolute control!

Here are some things to remember as a child of God:

God is everywhere. Jeremiah 23:24 – "Can anyone hide himself in secret places, so I shall not see him?' says the LORD; 'Do I not fill heaven and earth?' says the LORD."

<u>God has all knowledge</u>. <u>Hebrews 4:13</u> – "And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account."

<u>God's ways are perfect</u>. <u>Psalm 18:30</u> – "*As for God, <u>His way is perfect</u>; the word of the LORD is proven; He is a shield to all who trust in Him*".

<u>God is righteous</u>. <u>Psalm 145:17</u> – "...the LORD is <u>righteous in all His ways</u>, gracious in all His works."

<u>God is forgiving</u>. <u>Exodus 34:6-7</u> – "The LORD, the LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, <u>forgiving</u> <u>iniquity and transgression and sin</u> …"

<u>God is patient</u>. <u>2 Peter 3:9</u> – "*The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.*"

Another question people are asking is this... How can a loving God allow evil to happen in the world?

There seems to be a question in the minds of many... is God still good?

Genesis 1:31 – "Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good."

The problems we see today all started in the Garden of Eden with the first family.

<u>Genesis 3:8</u> – "And they heard the sound of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden."

The reason this first family hid themselves from the presence of the Lord is because they sinned against a good God.

"*Therefore*, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death *spread to all men*, because all sinned ..." **Romans 5:12.**

Amen."
