The Apostle Paul writes to the Church at Rome,

Romans 8:28-30 – "And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose. 29 For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren; 30 and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified."

Again, verse 28 - "... according to His purpose."

We must ask ourselves this question, up until this very day, "What has been my foremost purpose?"

What is God's purpose for you? What is this calling? He is God, and God created you.

Now, there is nothing wrong with planning and doing the best you can, under the control of the Holy Spirit. The problem is that we let this present world - system dictate to us what we are to be all about.

We are to be about this, seeking and saving the lost and encouraging them in spiritual growth.
