Pastor and leadership training will always be part of what we do when we accept invitations overseas for evangelism, discipleship, and training. *Ministry to ministers is ministry to multitudes*.

The Jesus Film - We've often heard this old phrase, "A picture is worth a thousand words." I know it is true for me. Sometimes when I'm studying complex concepts, trying to understand it deeply, I'll turn the page in a commentary and there will be a picture or diagram that sums up everything I've been pouring over. Watching "The Jesus Film" clearly tells the story, from the Gospel of Luke, of the life of Jesus. When people come face-to-face with Jesus, when they see Him smile, when they hear Him speak in their own language, with their own accent—they are forever changed. So, after the pastors' training conference, and the student conference during the day, we will, as the sun is going down, prepare to watch this film with more than 500 people each night in different villages. We are expecting some crowds to be nearly 2,500 people. A film can touch the heart and break barriers.

One of my all-time favorite books is entitled, <u>The Complete Green Letters</u> by Miles J. Stanford. This is a great and plainly written book on how to grow spiritually. Stanford makes this statement, "*The greatest ingredient for spiritual growth is need.*"

My friend, in these faraway places, we see people eager to see and hear from the Word of God. It's because they are needy. Most of the time, more can be done in two weeks where this need is so great, than in places that *have need of nothing. Revelation 3:17* 

We thank you for praying and for giving. God uses us to make it go far.
