I want you to think with me for just a moment and let me ask you four questions.

- 1. Who do others say that you are?
- 2. Who do you say that you are?
- 3. Who does God say that you are?
- 4. Which one is the real you?

You will immediately say, "The real me is who God says that I am." That's correct! Other people and your emotions may tell you one thing, but the absolute truth can only be found in God's Holy Word.

Take a quick look with me. Here is the real you if you are born again! You are right now and forever:
