When I reflect on the last 4 years, I am absolutely amazed at what has happened with me and this ministry in such a short time. It confirms for me, as always, God's call in the founding of 'Abiding Above Ministries.'

Here is a preview of the work God is doing through, 'Abiding Above Ministries:'

There have been 387 speaking engagements (Seminars, Revivals, Rescue Missions, Prisons, Children's Camps, International Crusades).

We have seen a total of **37,414 salvations** and **263 rededications!** Excluding our radio broadcasts this involves **10 States in the USA and 8 countries around the world that I have preached in!**

Our international crusades have been our greatest harvest, but our work in the local churches here in America, has also been greatly used by God.

In these days in which we are living, the need for making the most of time and resources is crucial. I do believe the Lord is coming soon. *Maranatha!*

Did you know the Bible instructs us to anticipate, and to long, and to look forward to His return? You see this in (1 Corinthians 16:22; Revelation 22:7,12,20).

The word 'Maranatha' was used as a greeting in early Christianity. When believers gathered or parted, they didn't say, "'hello' or 'goodbye' they said, 'Maranatha!'"

This is an Aramaic expression. In fact, it is made up of three Aramaic words: 'Mar,' which means 'Lord'; 'ana,' which means 'our'; and 'tha,' which means 'come.' "

So, when you put it together, '*Maranatha*' means, <u>"Our Lord, come."</u> It perfectly conveys the concept that the Lord could come at any moment.

Jesus said, "But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only." (Matthew 24:36).

"Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect." (Matthew 24:42-44).

Yes, only the Father knows when His Son is coming again, but if you will notice in scripture Jesus speaks of the many signs that will be upon us when He is at the door. He wants us to know, not the moment of His return, but to easily see His shadow just before you see Him. I believe we are seeing His shadow! Maranatha!

Reaching The Lost: Praise the Lord! I saw many come forward at the invitation when I preached at Memphis Union Mission the other day. Pray for them just now.

Please pray for me as I travel to preach in Arkansas twice in the month of June, and also to attend the Southern Baptist Convention in Louisville, KY. Pray that my meetings at the convention will bring much needed encouragement to many brothers in Christ.

Radio Broadcast: Praise the Lord! We are now on radio in Cape Town, South Africa! God continues to move us forward in reaching people through this medium.
