Revival in Kentucky: Your prayers were answered for the blessings of God upon the revival I led in Kentucky! We had showers of blessings as we watched 62 people make decisions for Jesus Christ!

We are fulfilling God's call on us to share the gospel of Jesus Christ with every person, to encourage spiritual growth in every believer, by the power of the Holy Spirit and to the glory of God.

This included my preaching in a local jail and a state penitentiary to many inmates. I am always moved by what I see when I minister in the prisons whether here in America or across the world to men and women who seem to have no hope. I shared with these inmates that all of our hope should rest alone in a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. This is true for everyone, whether free or in prison.

Jesus said,

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,

To proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord."

(Luke 4:18-19)



Walking in the Spirit: I believe with all of my heart that is what God has called me to do. It is humbling to know, that this same Jesus lives inside of me. If I will choose to surrender to His complete control this same Jesus will fulfill His mission that we see above through you and me. Marvelous! What wonder! To be filled with this same Spirit!
