I'm praying for you each day. I pray God continues to conform you to the image of His dear Son Jesus!

Paul said in Romans 8:29 – "For whom He foreknew, He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son"

Do people see the beauty of Jesus in you?

I'm praying that God will cause others to look upon you with favor and that He will bless all that you put your mind and hands too.

I want you to know this, as a minister of the gospel of Jesus Christ, and as President of Abiding Above Ministries; I have no inclination to compromise what is clear to me, God's will for His children, and His desire for the local church. I have not, and will not, subscribe to the latest fads and trends displayed in what has become known as the emergent church. Fads and trends are like the fashion of clothes; they change every year.

God's Holy Word says in <u>Hebrews 13:8</u> – "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever."

My friend, the church is the body of Christ. This means that we Christians are "in Christ" and if He never changes, we never change.

Paul said in Romans 12:2 – "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind"

Conformed – means not to be squeezed into Satan's mould.

Dear friend, do you feel like you are being forced into a mould of Christianity that frankly makes you feel uncomfortable? It should, and what you feel is both the resistance, and grieving, of the Holy Spirit inside of you. If you are walking in His Spirit, remembering you are in union with Him, when He resists worldliness you resist worldliness, and when He is grieved, you are grieved.

Again, we read what Paul says in Galatians 5:17 – "For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another"

As individuals, we know what it feels like to struggle with the flesh, and to grieve the Holy Spirit. The turmoil in the church today is the same turmoil we experience as individuals when the flesh wants to have its way. The answer? Surrender to the control of the Holy Spirit.

Ministry In St. Louis: I recently returned from St. Louis where I preached the morning message on the "Vine and the Branches," from John 15, and that evening I preached a message on "The Soon Return of Jesus Christ." This message was an eye opener for many, as we looked at the clear signs from scripture that His coming is near.
