Each month when I'm in town I travel 2 to 3 times into the inner city to Memphis Union Mission, fulfilling the God-given opportunity to speak into the lives of homeless men. I absolutely love being a part of the solution to what troubles the fallen children of the first man Adam.

"Therefore, just as through one man sin entered into the world, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men, because all sinned—" Romans 5:12

The men agree; our problems are not what we are being told. Our problem is simply three letters that spell one word, **Sin**.

Having officiated several funerals just recently, I'm reminded of the brevity of life. My friend, if you've been thinking about doing something for Jesus, the time is now. Simply let Him have all there is of you, and He will certainly use you. Let's remember what the Bible says:

While performing a beautiful outdoor wedding, I was reminded again how God's order continues on.

I left the retreat charged and ready to go as I was scheduled to preach in the Mississippi Delta the next day. I preached morning and evening at Oakhurst Baptist Church. We also made evangelistic visits in a neighborhood near the church between worship services.
