It was a joy to preach at Memphis Union Mission on the last day of November in their new facility. God has truly blessed them! This much needed facility upgrade will greatly improve their ministry to homeless men in the Memphis area. I brought a message that was entitled "A Man and His Friends." I taught them that it is nearly impossible to be different from those you associate with on a regular basis. I encouraged them to take an assessment of their present friendships and to make a decision immediately to walk, and even run away from those men who consistently bring others down around them. I quoted several times something I used to hear my father say when I was a child, "*Birds of a feather flock together.*"

As I finished my message to them, I gave a gospel plea and we heard many praying and asking Christ to come into their lives. To God be the glory, great things He has done!
