He prayed to receive Christ. He told me he was traveling to Texas to start all over and had a job promised to him. I offered him a few dollars but he would not take them. Later that day, I saw them again walking down a street. As they passed by me, the man waved and smiled broadly and tears again began to flow down his cheeks.

I received a blessing while handing out hundreds of tracts on a street corner as people were rushing in and out of a farmers' market. I looked up and saw a man doing the same thing (handing out tracts) across the street. He was not a part of our team, but a faithful man of God doing the same thing we were doing what the Holy Spirit was leading him to do.





We encouraged each other and I led in a time of prayer together and then we turned away and continued casting gospel seeds.
