
Standing with my dad at the front of the engine I engineered on my last day with the railroad.

Whether it is evangelizing in the streets of New York, as we did last year,






Presenting the gospel to the people of New York

Presenting the Jesus Film in the towns of America and Kenya,




Presenting the Jesus Film to the people in America's small towns.
